To change, simply go to "Settings" and then pick which type you want. It changes without losing any of your data.

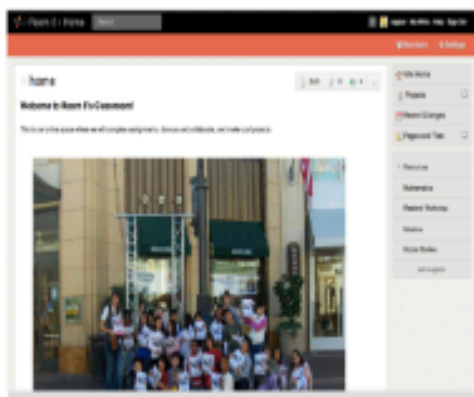
Application Type

Designed for teachers and students. Includes our news feed and formative assessment features.

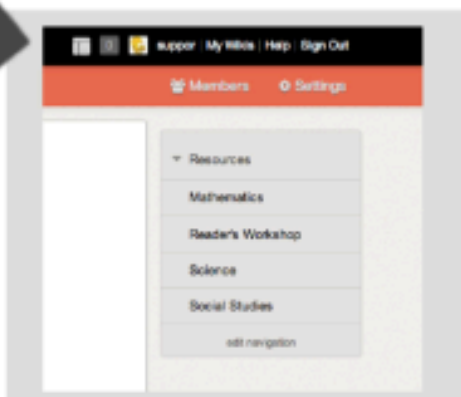
